1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how SecurityHQ (“we”, “us”, “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies on our website:

This policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, and how you can control their use. It should be read alongside our Privacy Policy.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They enable websites to function efficiently, improve user experience, and provide information to site owners.

Cookies may be:

- Session cookies – deleted when you close your browser
- Persistent cookies – remain on your device for a defined period.

3. Types of cookies we use

3.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the Website to operate and cannot be switched off.

They are used to:

- Enable core functionality such as page navigation
- Maintain security and prevent fraud
- Support system administration

These cookies do not require consent.

3.2 Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our Website, allowing us to improve performance and usability.

They may collect:

- Number of visitors
- Pages visited
- Time spent on pages
- Traffic sources

These cookies are only placed with your consent.

3.3 Functional Cookies

These cookies enable enhanced functionality and personalisation.

They may be used to:

- Remember user preferences
- Store language or region settings

These cookies require your consent.

3.4 Marketing Cookies

Marketing cookies track browsing behaviour to help deliver relevant advertising.

They may be used by:

- Advertising platforms
- Social media providers

These cookies are only used where you provide explicit consent.

4. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies on our Website are set by third-party service providers.

These may include:

- Analytics providers (e.g. Google Analytics)
- Marketing and advertising platforms
- Embedded content providers

These third parties may collect information about your online activity over time and across different websites. We do not control these cookies and recommend reviewing their respective privacy policies.
